

The Importance of Recycling

Many of us do not think about the impact that improper disposal of a printer ink or toner cartridge can have. Global projections indicate that by 2012 there will be 500 million toner cartridges and 1.8 billion ink cartridges deposited in landfills, with each one taking up to 1,000 years to break-down due to the plastic components used for their manufacture. To make matters even worse, for every new laser cartridge that is produced, roughly 3 litres of fossil fuels are used.

However, it has been estimated that 20 to 30% of all ink and toner cartridges sold worldwide are remanufactured. This is significant progress for an industry that is still relatively new. Cartridge recycling in the United Kingdom alone could save 15 million liters of oil from being used within one year (equivalent of 7.5 Olympic sized swimming pools.) Picture the positive impact that you would have on Ethiopia by conserving the limited resources and landfilling space by simply being more mindful of where you dispose of your used printing consumables.

After the toner cartridge has passed the inspection stage (for quality and condition), the entire cartridge is then separated and sent to the cleaning station, where pressurized ion-free air is used to clean all traces of the left over toner powder into our 'High Efficiency Toner Containment Unit." Next, the cartridge is fully disassembled into its core components on our assembly line and all mechanisms that exhibit signs of

wear or damage are immediately replaced. Only once the cartridge has been fully cleaned, maintained and serviced does it advance into the "clean room." Our clean room is our anti-static, dust-free space where we use our precision filling machine to give you exactly the right amount of toner powder per cartridge. Many OEM cartridges are not filled completely (especially the demonstration units that come free in a printer) and thus end up running out of toner before reaching their full printing potential.
